We excited that you decided to take a closer look at what it means to be an Agape at S.O.S. Camp. SOS Camp is designed to provide mentally and physically challenged persons of all ages with an opportunity to enjoy a week of exploration, education, and fun. In order to put together a successful program, Shetek is looking for mature and responsible young adults to serve as Agape for our incredible campers. Agapes serve as assistants and friends for 1-3 campers during the week. To be eligible you must be 14 years of age. The application process is simple:

1. Fill out the application form.
2. Give the reference form, along with a stamp-addressed envelope to a pastor, teacher, coach, or other non-related adult who knows you well.
3. Send your application to Shetek as soon as you are able, but please, no later than June 1, 2009.

Your week as an Agape will be a challenging, growth-filled week. Your responsibility would be to encourage campers to participate in the daily activities and events, get to the camp nurse on time to receive any medications, as well as attend to their daily needs. All Agape are supervised by trained Shetek summer staff, so you will have someone to turn to with questions or to ask for help. Although there is no monetary compensation, the rewards will come in many other ways.

If selected as an Agape, you will meet on Sunday, July 5, 2009 for training and orientation. Campers will arrive on Monday and depart on Friday. Additional information will be sent to you after your application has been received.
